



How to Vote Instructions

1. Receive & Open Your Ballot

Ballots are mailed 19 days before the election. If you don't receive your ballot before July 28th, check [MyVote](#) to make sure your information is correct.

2. Mark your ballot

Mark your ballot by completely shading in the box to the left of your choice with a black or blue ink pen. If you want to vote for a candidate not appearing on the ballot, mark the box to the left of Write-In and use the dotted line provided to indicate your choice. **Be sure to mark only one choice for each race or measure on the ballot.**



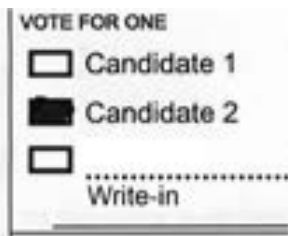
Example: Candidate 2 has been chosen.

One candidate has been marked and the box is filled in completely.

3. Check your ballot

Check your ballot to be sure you have voted for the candidates and measures you intended. Make sure you mark only one response box in each race or measure.

If you mark more than one, your vote in that race will not be counted. Your other votes will be counted if they are done correctly.



If you make a mistake marking your ballot, draw a line through the incorrectly marked choice as shown. You then have the option of marking another choice.

4. Secrecy Sleeve

Place your completed ballot into the secrecy envelope and seal it. This is an important step to ensure your ballot is accepted.

5. Return Envelope

Place the ballot and secrecy sleeve into the return envelope.

6. Sign Your Return Envelope

You must sign and date your return envelope in order for your ballot to be counted!

Read the oath on the envelope and sign the return envelope that has your name on it. Ballots are not accepted without a signature or the wrong signature (Be sure this the same signature that you used when registering to vote.)

7. Cast Your Ballot

Return your ballot by mail, or at any of the ballot drop boxes by 8PM election night (list available in the voter pamphlet). No postage is needed. Ballots must be postmarked no later than election day to be counted.

Frequently Asked Questions

How can I change my vote?

Draw a line through the entire candidate's name or measure response. You then have the option of making another choice. Do not use white out or erase.

How do I add a name to the ballot?

If you would like to add a person's name that is not already printed on the ballot, use the 'Write-In' section to write their full name.

How can I receive a New Ballot?

If your ballot becomes lost, damaged, or spoiled you can get a replacement by calling the Elections Office. You may also visit [MyVote](#) and download a replacement ballot.

Can I vote on behalf of someone?

Every voter has the right to vote his or her ballot in secret. Any person attempting to vote when he or she is not entitled or who falsely signs the oath shall be guilty of a felony, punishable by imprisonment for not more than five years or a fine of not more than \$10,000, or both such fine and imprisonment.
